New Volunteers (onboarding clearance):

You will need health clearance (TB) from Employee Health Services (EHS). Once you have had your photo taken by Human Resources, please bring the *yellow carbon copy receipt* to EHS to begin the health clearance process.

Annual Clearance Instructions:

Please take your badge to EHS to obtain your annual health clearance.

Employee Health Services is located in the Faculty Medical Office (FMO) at:
